Subject: **Sehat Sahulat Card and Private patients.**

Dear Boards of Governors, MTIs Khyber Pakhtunkhwa,


Review of the practice at several KP MTIs indicates confusion on the management of Sehat Sahulat Card (SSC) patients and private patients seen during institution based private practice (IBP).

To clarify this, please note:

1. SSC patients are seen as routine hospital patients during regular working hours. The doctors' fees that are part of the bundle agreed with State Life are given in full to the doctor concerned when payment is received from State Life. *Doctors who do not participate in IBP and practice outside are not eligible for these payments.*
2. If a patient chooses to be seen as a private patient in IBP, they cannot avail of the SSC program; these patients are treated as private patients and charged accordingly. This means that regular SSC patients cannot be seen as private patients unless they themselves decide to be seen as private patients and pay private patient fees. When this happens, the institution cannot charge State Life any costs, since the patient is not being seen as an SSC patient but as a purely private patient.
3. It follows that no patients seen in IBP are considered SSC patients and the MTI cannot double-charge the costs (State Life + patient).
